\* If you didn't have a child living with you, but you are a worker between the ages of 25 and 65 and earned less than \$12,590 (or \$14,590 for a married couple), you are probably eligible for a smaller credit – up to \$428.

\*\* The income limits are \$2,000 higher for married couples filing jointly.
