* If you didn't have a child living with you, but you are a worker between the ages of 25 and 65 and earned less than \$12,880 (or \$15,880 for a married couple), you are probably eligible for a smaller credit – up to \$438.

** The income limits are \$3,000 higher for married couples filing jointly.
